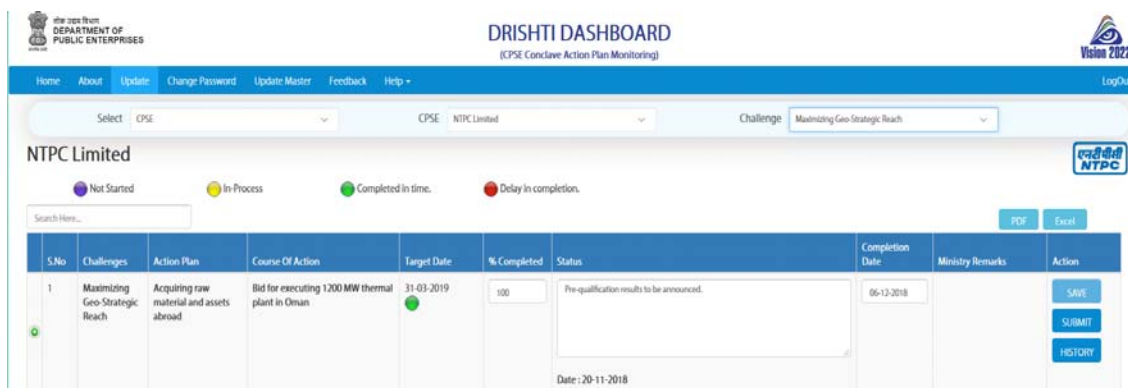


The dashboard is designed to monitor the [CPSE Conclave](#) Action Plans for realizing the challenges posed by the honourable Prime Minister to Central Public Sector Enterprises

Data is privileged and can be accessed only thru authentication. CPSEs, Controlling Ministries, DPE and Committee of Secretaries (COS) are given login based access.

The blue menu bar has a login link on the extreme right and other action links are aligned left. The login credentials are email id registered in the **System** as user id and the pass key or password that had been mailed (system mail) to the individual user. The Reset Password link can be used in case password is forgotten. The Change Password option can be used to change current password. All users are recommended to change the initial password mailed to their registered email by the system.

After login the Update link in the menu will become active and a new link **Update Master** will appear in the menu bar



Every CPSE is required to maintain the action plans challenge wise. Data maintenance is a two-step process (after log in).

1. Master Data Maintenance (click Update Master). This is the first step. This (master data maintenance) is applicable for the first three challenges only namely
 - a. Maximizing Geo Strategic Reach
 - b. Minimizing Import Bills and
 - c. Integration of Innovation and Research

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You can add record by clicking the **Add Record** link. Or edit the existing record by clicking **Edit** under the column Action. You can also **Delete** a Record if it is not required or in case the record is not correct etc. Every *Challenge* may have one or more *Action Plans* and every Action Plan may have one or more *Course of Action*. The **Target Date** is for the unique combination of Challenge, Action Plan and Course of Action. One Record may have a **Milestone** and a Date (Milestone Date) for realizing that Mile stone

You can change or delete a record as long as it is not subsequently acted upon (see below)

2. Update Records (click Update)

Every record in the master data created in the previous step requires to be updated by the concerned CPSE for % completed before the Milestone Date or the Target Date (anticipated date by which 100% will be completed for the unique combination of Challenge, Action Plan and Course of Action) and Status as on the date when the data is being updated (Status Date will be automatically appended by the system below the status). The controlling Ministry also can update any record by putting Ministry's Remarks and Remarks Date.

Every record if changed will have Save and Submit buttons. The Save button will save the data for the CPSE only. It may not be visible to Ministry and DPE. The Submit will make the data change permanent and will be available to the Ministry and DPE. The Excel and PDF buttons are all active to output the data appropriately

3. *Master Data Maintenance is not required for challenges (3-7, 7th is thematic presentations and is not really a challenge posed)*. The structural lay out for these are different from the first three challenges. Where as in the case of the first three challenges individual CPSE is expected to maintain masters (master data) this is not required in the cases of challenges 3-7. For these the recommendations and measurable indicators have been preset and the individual is expected to maintain the measurable indicator(s) as applicable to the CPSE

4. *Single CS scheme*: The recommendation is "Every year a theme would be identified and communicated and 60% of the CSR fund of the CPSE is to be utilized for this scheme.

The **Status** would expect a number that is total CSR fund allocated for the year (In the Year field the relevant Year can be mentioned). The amount to be utilized for the annual theme that is 60% of the total would be calculated and placed in the greyed cell under **status**. Extend of fund utilized for annual theme of school Education and health care in Rs crores

can be given in the next row (number is expected in the field). In the next row (1.3) the list of projects funded under *CSR* in *aspirational districts* may be give (Text field. List the projects in order). Suitable remarks can be input and clicking **update** will update all the 4 rows

5. *New Development Model*: The lay out is similar to the single CSR scheme. Recommendations and Measurable Indicators expect CPSE responses. Some recommendations are specific to some CPSEs only e.g. Development of /Conversion to mini smart cities/townships are applicable to the following CPSE only as under:

6. *Other Challenges*

The lay out is similar and recommendations and measurable indicators require CPSE s to respond and input values in the Status and Year Fields. In some cases Status field expects numeric values. Where Yes or No is expected based on the inputs rows could be greyed out depending on applicability. A single update command (click update button) will update the inputs for the recommendation/measurable indicator. Some Challenges are specific to some ministry only. e.g.

Providing long term linkages to Steel CPSEs so that washeries can be set up by them in the coal field for Coking Coal and To look at domestic as well as foreign collaboration opportunities would appear only for **Steel Ministry**

- 7. Thematic Presentations:** The lay out is similar and recommendations and measurable indicators require CPSE s to respond and input values in the Status and Year Fields. Month is also active. Cumulative values for subsequent months for a specific year would be required in the status field
